Responsibilities & Duties:

- Perform preventative and predictive maintenance on mobile and stationary equipment, including front end loaders, dozers, trucks, blower trucks, walking floors, excavators and other company owned equipment.
- Perform operation test prior to repairs to verify complaint
- Diagnose cause of any malfunction and perform repairs to manufacturer's specifications.
- Follow paper-flow procedures including documenting correct mileage/hours, save and tag all warranty and core parts, document all repairs on work order using complaint, cause and correction format.
- Perform required inspections and preventative maintenance on vehicles and equipment to maximize the safety, productivity and life of the unit.
- Maintains a safe and clean working environment by complying with procedures, rules and regulations.
- Welding and fabrication as required
- Daily fueling of yard equipment
- Various other tasks as required
- Build and maintain blower hose inventory for the fleet
