- Responsible preparation and accurate record keeping of Fleet maintenance
- Check heavy equipment using approved circle check procedures before operating to ensure mechanical, safety, and emergency equipment is in good working order
- Adhere to workplace safety policies, regulations and compliances
- Communicate any unsafe conditions or accidents/injuries in a timely manner to the supervisor in order to facilitate prompt correction or reporting.
- Diagnose / identify defects in heavy duty equipment and able to promptly respond to any issue, seeking assistance when necessary to
- Accurate completion of work orders and time cards
- Clean, lubricate and perform other minor maintenance work.
- Complete all necessary paperwork (may include, but is not limited to, daily logs, inspection logs, equipment inspection, hours of service, etc....
- Pre-trips equipment daily and reports as per company and industry requirements
