Hemlock/Fir Bark Mulch

- A brownish/red colour you expect for that natural look
- Effective weed deterrent
- Knits together well
- Not suitable for use as a soil amendment
- Recommended depth: 3-4 inches



Black / Red Coloured Mulch

- Manufactured mulch made with clean fibre and our proprietary colorfast mulch products
- Colours include red and black
- Excellent weed control
- Long lasting and durable
- These mulches make a statement
- Recommended depth: 3 inches plus



Aged Mulch

- Rich Brown/black colour
- Great visual appeal
- Finer particle size
- Used to complement the landscape
- Less effective as a weed deterrent as it will become part of the soil
- Recommended depth: 3-4 inches



NutriMend

- Technically a compost but it can be used as mulch
- Revives tired soil by adding organic content
- Does not provide weed control but makes the soil easier to maintain
- Provides a natural look 2-6 inches depending on soil requirements
- Not recommended for use as planting soil on its own
- Can be used as an amendment
