- Communicates with Blower Operator prior to, during and upon completion of job
- Pre-trips equipment as per Denbow procedures
- Post trip installer vehicles to ensure everything is back in place or restocked.
- Signs-out and brings required tools to jobsite
- Brings all equipment from job site back to Denbow
- Sets up hose and prepares jobsite for installation as directed by Blower Operator or Job Forman
- Pneumatically installs forest by-products including chips, shavings and sawdust on jobsites in agricultural barns, pens, stalls, nurseries and landscape products such as mulches, soils and aggregates in areas as directed by Blower Operator.
- Liaises with clients onsite as required
- Performs cleanup on jobsites to Denbow standards
